National Credit Union Administration Issues Civil Money Penalties

February 27, 2007- Alexandria, Va.,— During the fourth quarter of 2006, the National Credit Union Administration (NCUA) assessed Civil Money Penalties against 22 federally insured credit unions that were late in submitting 2005 Home Mortgage Disclosure Act (HMDA) data.
