### Steve Bosack Joins Chairman Matz as Chief of Staff



October 13, 2009 Alexandria, Va. – Steve Bosack returns today to a second stint at NCUA, now serving as chief of staff to Chairman Debbie Matz. Bosack previously served as senior policy advisor to Matz during her first term on the NCUA Board.

Since September 2005, Bosack was deputy director at the National Credit Union Foundation (NCUF). Bosack helped oversee numerous NCUF programs, including REAL Solutions, Credit Union Development Education, Social Impact Management, Innovation Grants, federal grants and CUAid. He played a major role in disaster relief efforts by helping distribute a record \$3.5 million in grants to credit unions on the U.S. Gulf

Coast following Hurricane Katrina.

At NCUA from 2003 to 2005, Bosack worked with Board Member Matz on regulations, policies and programs to facilitate member outreach, attract underserved consumers, and encourage credit unions to develop and share best practices.

Bosack served as vice president of communications at the Credit Union National Association (CUNA) during the previous 10 years. A highlight was participating in public relations and coalition building behind the Credit Union Campaign for Consumer Choice. He helped forge relationships with the Consumer Federation of America and other consumer advocates to publicly encourage consumers to join credit unions, and he contributed to enactment of the Credit Union Membership Access Act of 1998.

Bosack graduated with honors from Boston College in 1987, earning a double major in Communications and Economics. He is a member of the International Economics Honor Society, and while at CUNA he earned certification as a Credit Union Development Educator (CUDE).

Steve and his wife, Maria, have 3 children.
